This property is contiguous to the beloved Hirschman Trail and Pond, the cornerstone of the Cement Hill neighborhood, and the western gateway to historic Nevada City. This acquisition will expand Hirschman Trail Open Space, and carry out the intent of the City's Scenic Corridor goals for Highway 49.



With community support, we can acquire this property, rehabilitate the site to join aesthetically, culturally and biologically with Hirschman Trail and Pond and then donate it to Nevada City as open space in perpetuity.
